Meaning of PPP

- PPP= Public Private Partnership is a contractual arrangement between public and private sector entities built on the expertise of each partner that has best meets clearly defined public needs through the most appropriate allocations of resources, risk and rewards.
- The cooperation may involve construction, renovations, maintenance, management or provision of services.

- To introduce fair, equitable, transparent, competitive and cost-effective procurement process for PPPs
- To adopt operational guidelines and creteria
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- To attract resources for development of PPPs
 - To develop institutional capacities for technical analysis and negotiations of PPPs and associated contracts; and
 - To enhance efficient and quality implementations of PPPs

Coordination unit for PPP

- This deals with establishment and administration of the coordinations unit. It is stipulated in the PPP Act No 18 section 5 c and 6 which provides for the functions and appointment of the coordinator. In part III of the act states roles of the Public Private Sector responsibilities

Responsibilities of Regional Coordinator

- Subject to section 6 of the act, PPP is implemented in the whole region basing on nature and type of the Project
- To provide technical support in policy translation
- Networking for stakeholders across the Region
- Advocacy, Dissemination of guidelines of PPP in the region including friendly environment for actors
- Supervision and Monitoring of PPP in the Region

Private Party Responsibilities

- Identify projects
- Carry out feasibility study
- Mobilizing resources
- Implement project
- Sensitization and awareness creation

PPP Project Sustainability

- For PPP to prosper, mechanism for sustainability must be in place, since considerable resources are invested in PPP projects, by both Government as well Private sector

In order for PPP to be sustainable in our Region, it is recommended that.

- All keys players have common understanding of the PPP concepts and its implementations

Recomm.....

- A proper feasibility study to be conducted prior to the implementation of the PPP project to ensure achievement of the desired project goals
- All parties involved should be committed in implementing the PPP projects
- There is support from political leaders and community leaders

Monitoring of PPP in the Region

- Monitoring is continuing function that aims primarily ongoing interventions which early indications of progress, or achievements of results
- It involves systematic and continuing tracking of activities planned against actual implementations
- Monitoring of PPP should be done during performing our daily duties; for example during construction of roads, we expect to see employments created

Ares to be monitored in PPP

- Performance and implementation of PPP policy in the Regions
- Quality of Service delivery to our clients
- Standard agreed before implementations
- Revenue generated from the project and expenditures with respect to budget
- Profit or benefits generated by our partners

PPP

- PPP is a framework to provide important instruments for attracting investment as it is the case in holistic development approaches, since the government is striving to provide affordable and quality social services
- Due to recognition of PPP in facilitation social development in Tanzania

Communications

- PPP involves local development partners who need to be informed about policies and legislations
- Visits ...physical going to the projects areas to see the real performance
- Meetings ...Partners do meets to exchanges ideas and ways of maintaining their relationship

FUTURE PLANS

- Every LGA has established PPP desk by appointing a coordinator who will liaise between the council and the Private sector societies which involve all NGOs, FBOs, Business community and saving and lending groups such as VICOBA and SILC

OUTPUT

- We expect PPP to produce employment opportunities to youths who forms 60% of the population in our LGAs
- Transportation and constructions sectors do contributes much in employing youth and women communities who are I informal sectors
- We expect by 2020 every LGA to create I500 employment opportuniities
